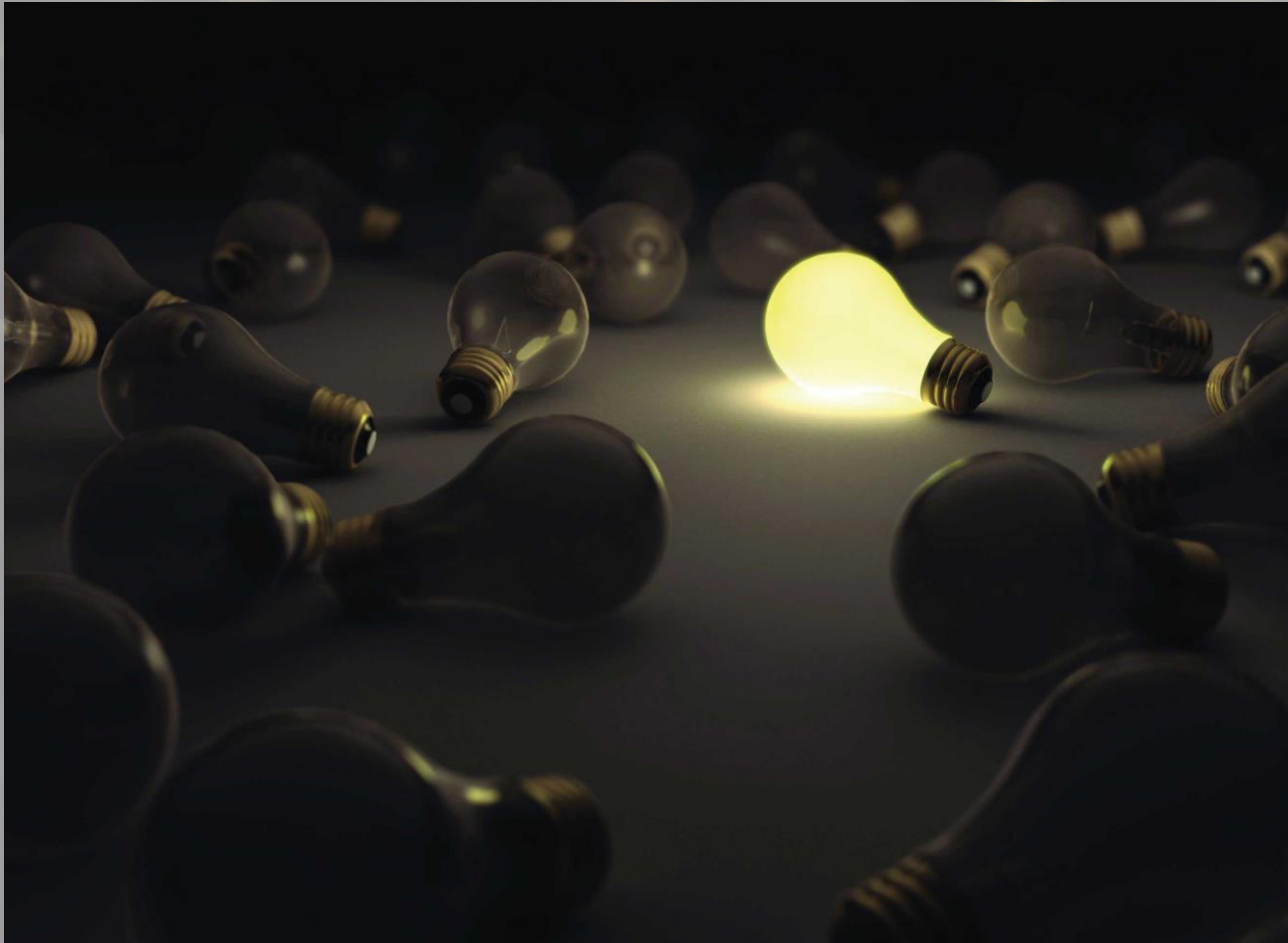

Hebrews 2:14 ... the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. ¹⁵ Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying. ... ¹⁷ Therefore, it was necessary for him to be made in every respect like us, so that he could be our merciful and faithful High Priest before God.
