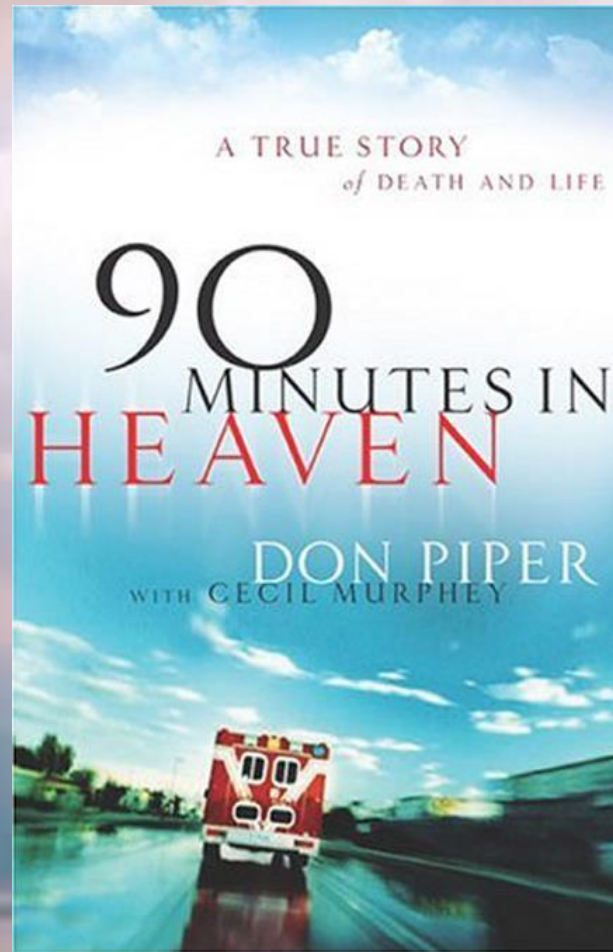
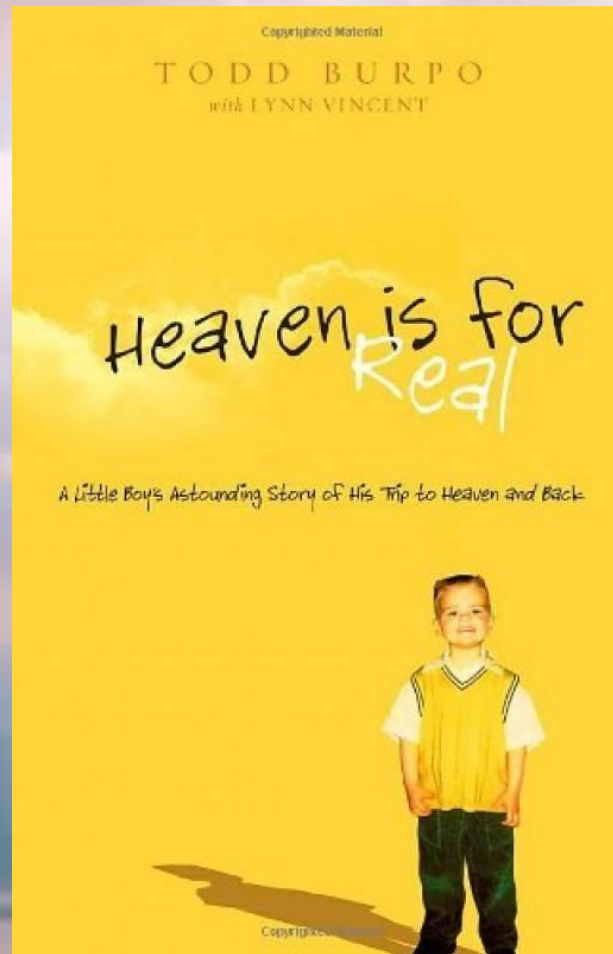

Misconception #1: The present heaven, where the soul of a follower of Jesus goes when they die, is the same place that we will live forever.



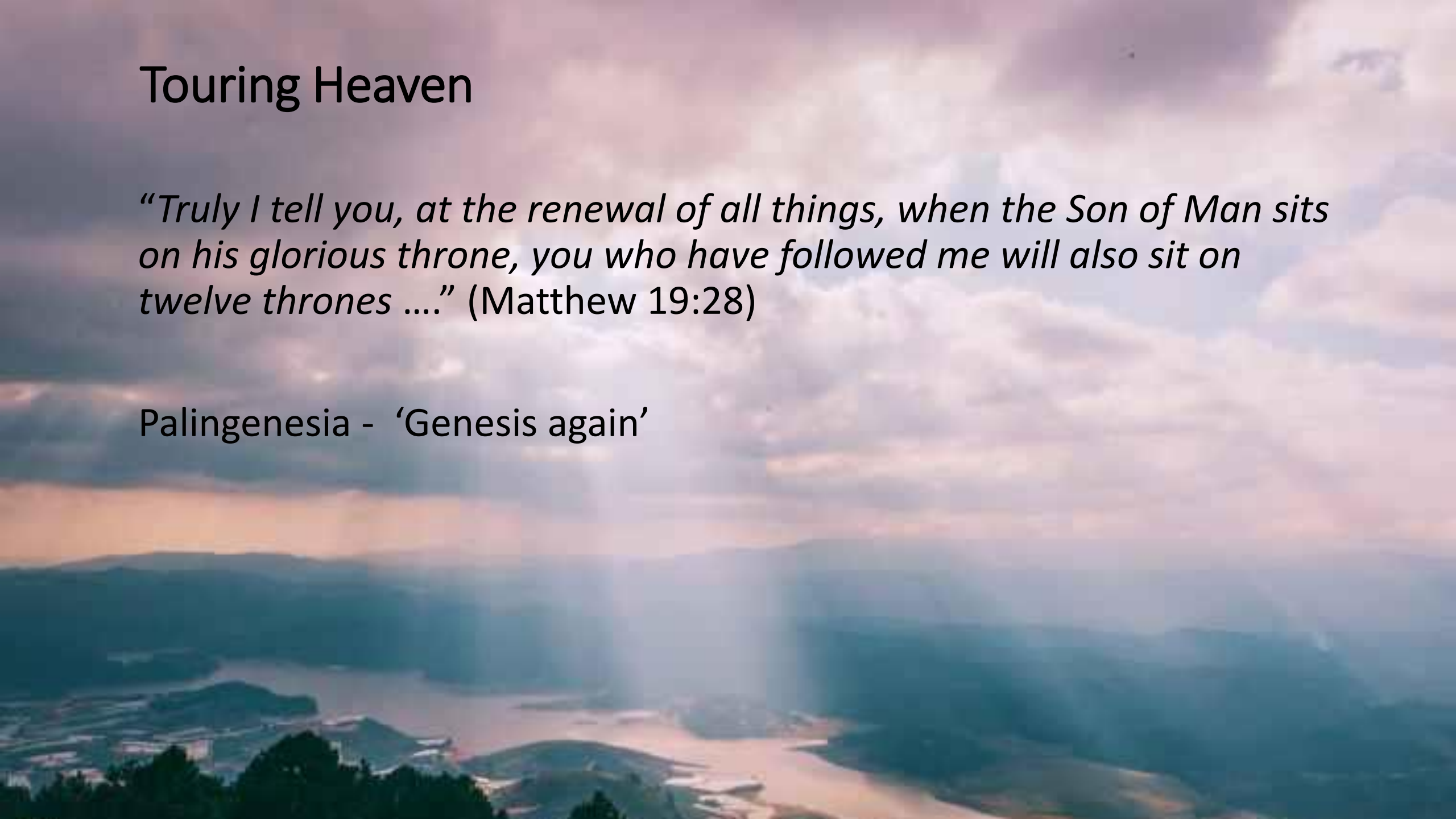

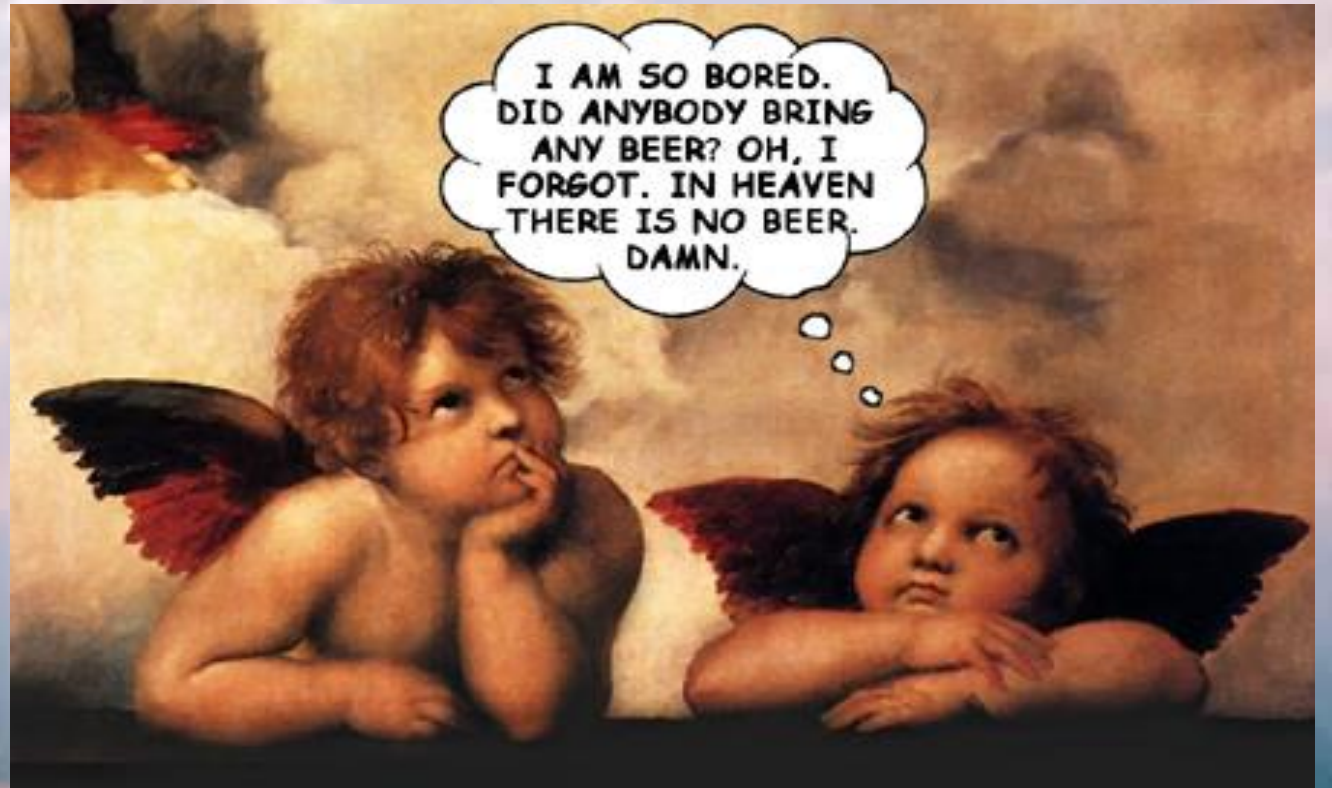

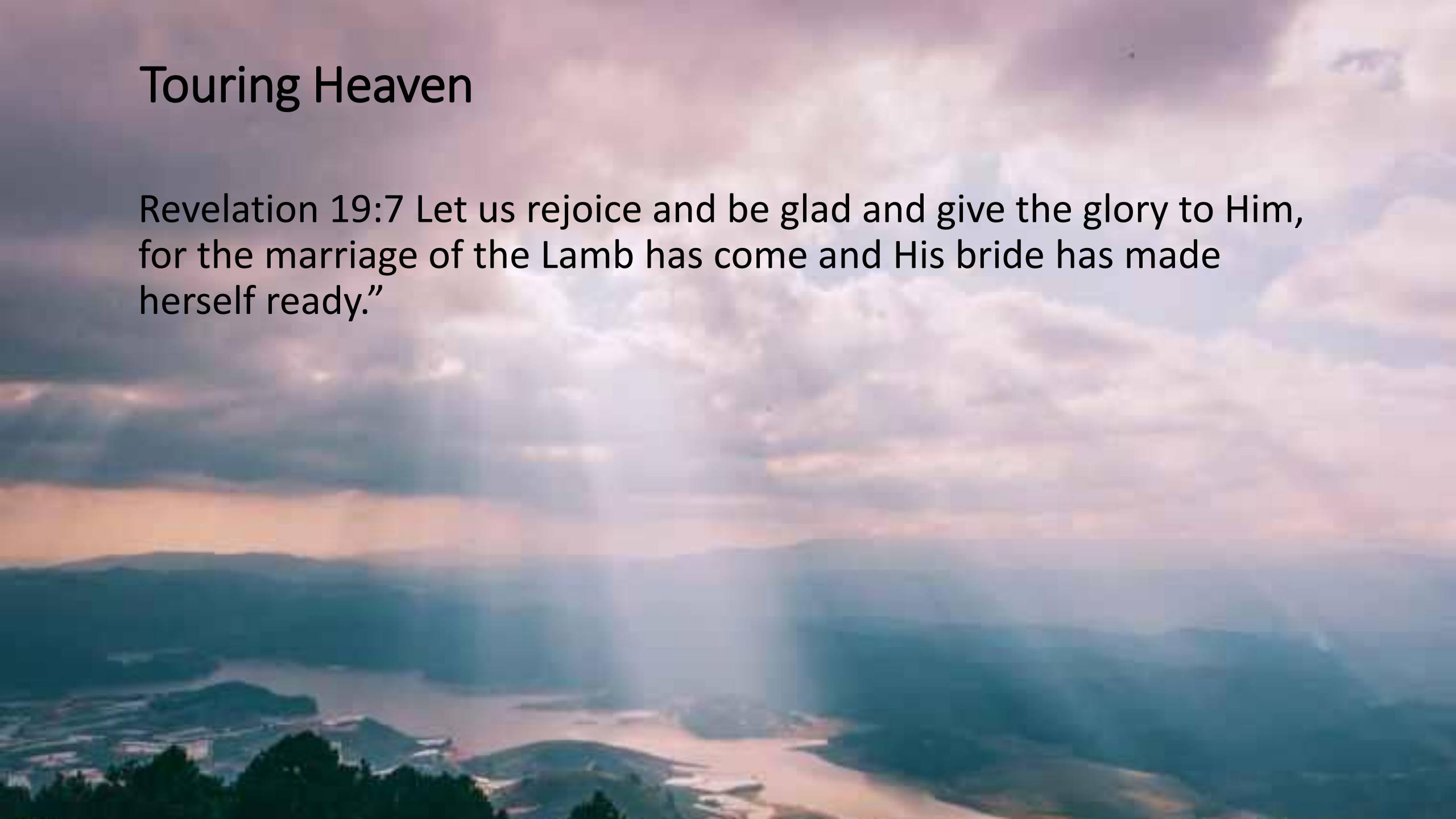

Misconception #2: Heaven will be boring. Heaven will be an eternal church worship service.



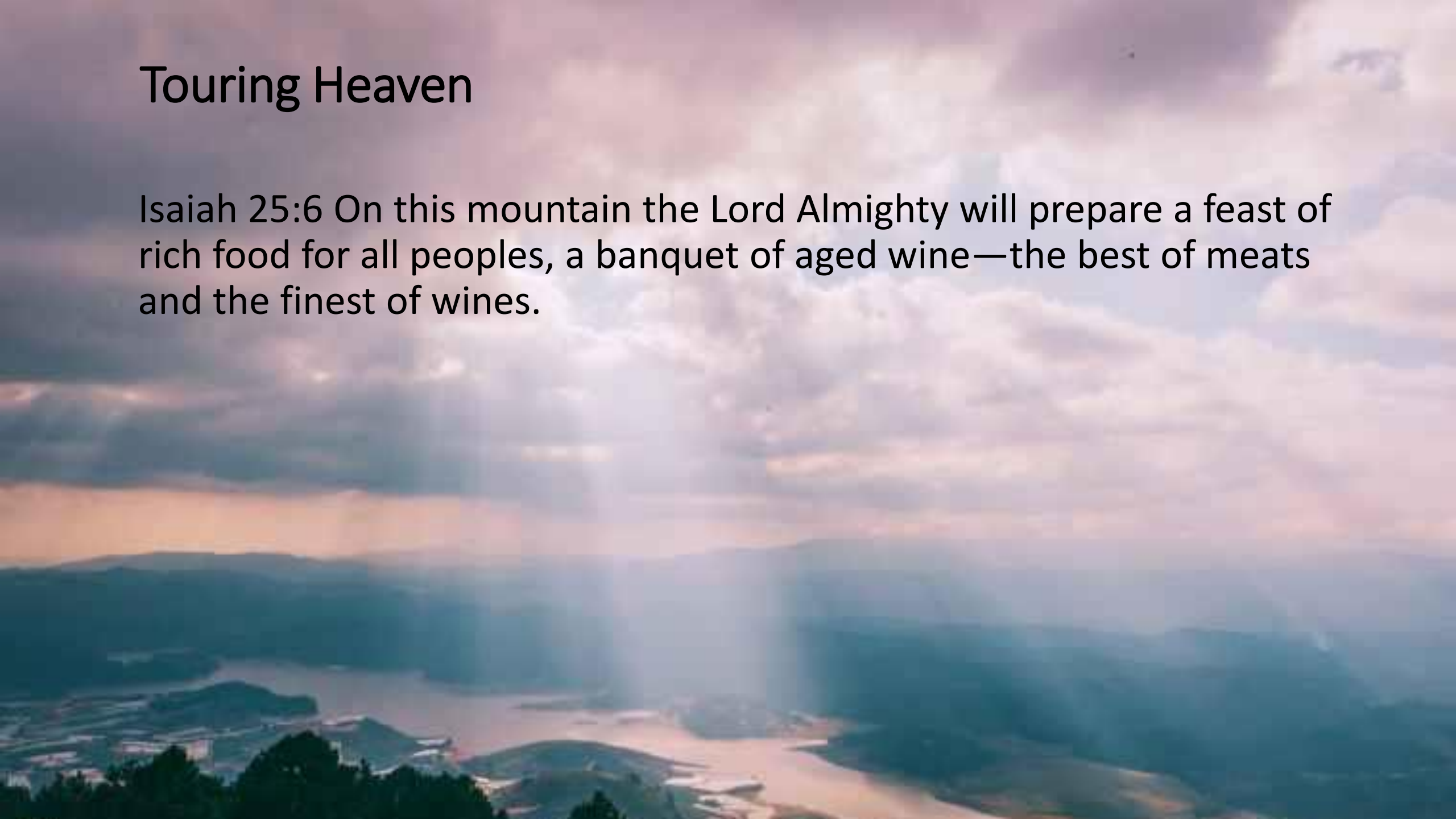
