(Matthew 5:40-43)

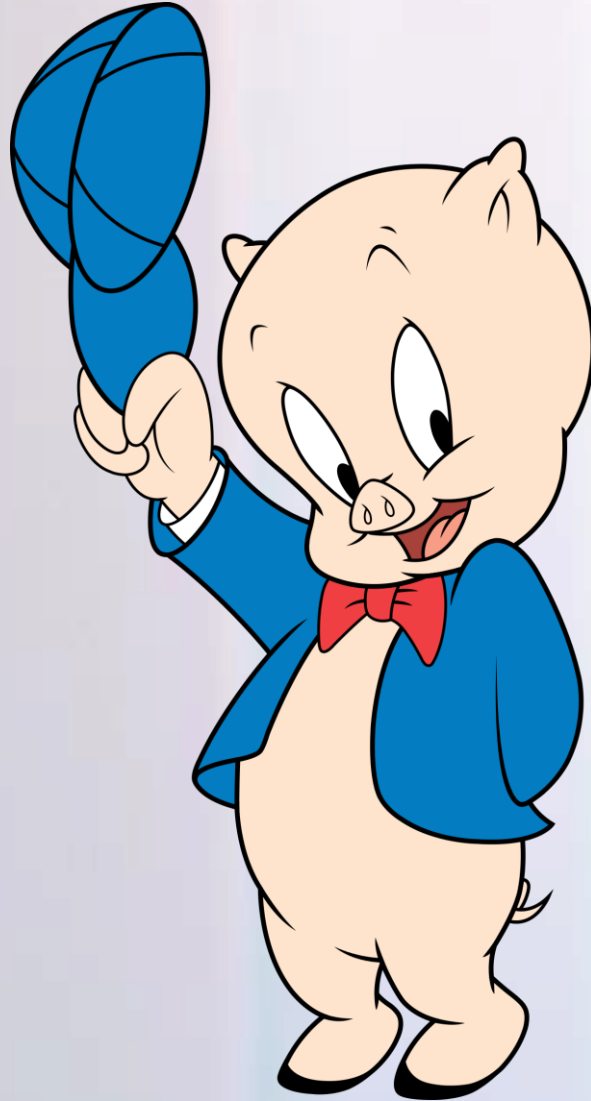
