^{2:1} We must pay the most careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.

^{4:7} Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts. (see also 3:8; 3:15)

Hebrews 5:11-6:2

5:11 We have much to say about this, but it is hard to make it clear to you because you no longer try to understand.

^{5:12} In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food!

Hebrews 5:11-6:2

^{5:13} Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. ¹⁴ But solid food is for the mature, who by <u>constant use</u> have <u>trained</u> themselves to distinguish good from evil.

Hebrews 5:11-6:2

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Romans 3:22 This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile,

Hebrews 5:11-6:2

6:1 Therefore <u>let us</u> move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ and be taken forward to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God, ² instruction about cleansing rites, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.
