1 John 3:2 Dear friends, <u>now</u> we are children of God, and what we will be has <u>not yet</u> been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart. ²³ For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.
