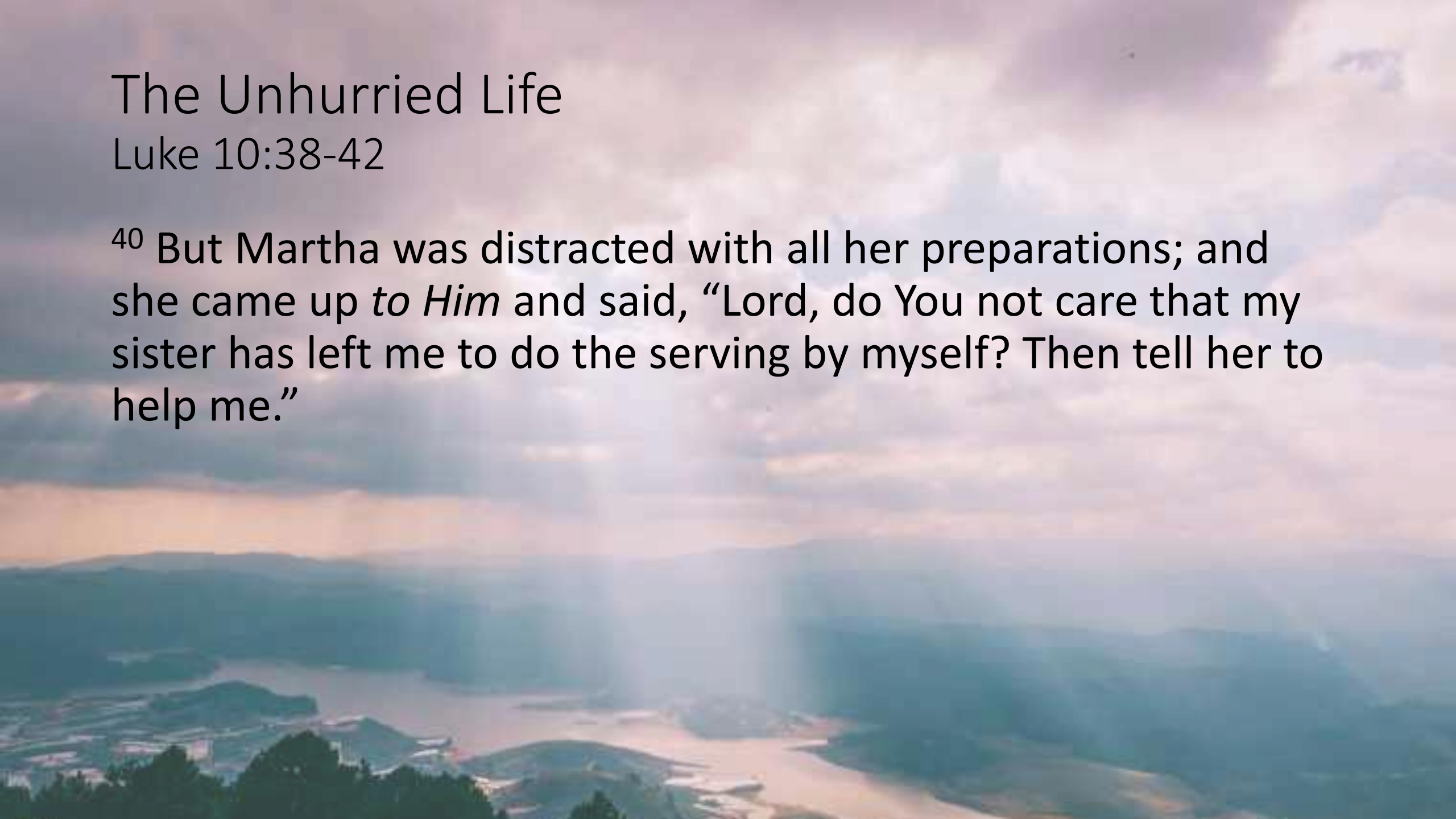
Luke 10:38 Now as they were traveling along, He entered a village; and a woman named Martha welcomed Him into her home.

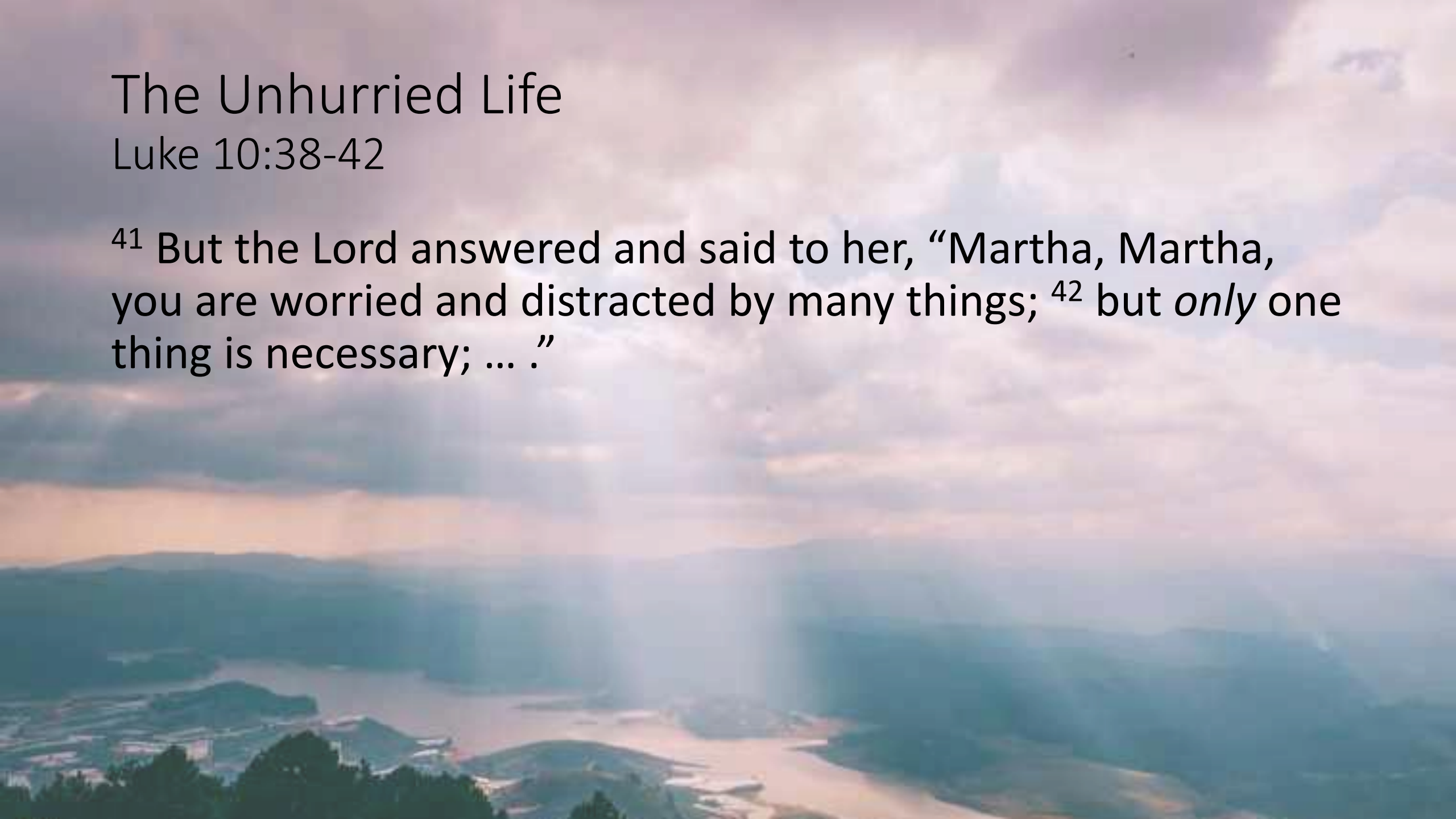
